Gentlemen:

Did you receive my telegram sent Monday night? Wired you concerning my arrest. Whitehead and Vogl are my attorneys. Will you help me in this fight?

Reason for refusing to answer questionnaire: if I answered it, I would virtually join the military forces; when called for service, if I refused to go, I would be subject to Court Martial and could not take my stand as a conscientious objector. By not answering the questionnaire, I can fight my case thru the federal courts attacking the constitutionality of the questionnaire and taking my stand as a conscientious objector.

The questionnaire arrangement is quite germane to our fight against the establishment of militarism in America, as the filling out of the questionnaires is the first step in the plan to militarize the United States.
